## Saint-Barnard collegiate church A medieval jewel

Overlooking the Isère river in the heart of Romans' historical centre, the Saint-Barnard collegiate church, listed as a Historical Monument since 1840, is an essential part of local heritage. Founded in 838 by Archbishop Barnard of Vienne, the presentday building took shape between the 12th and 18th centuries and majestically blends Roman and Gothic architecture. Rising 38 metres high and stretching 66 meters long, it is impressing both by its scale and by the richness of its decoration: a majestic nave, organ, chapels, stainedglass windows, and above all the magnificent 14th century frescoes in the choir-masterpieces of medieval art. Open daily: 9 a.m. - 7 p.m.
